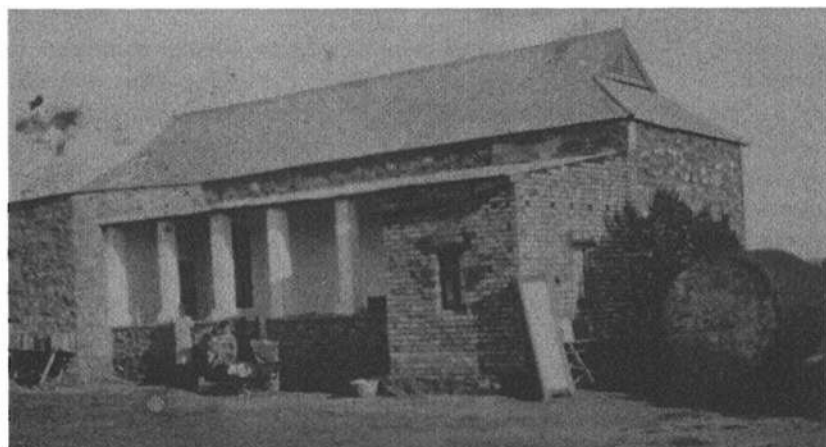

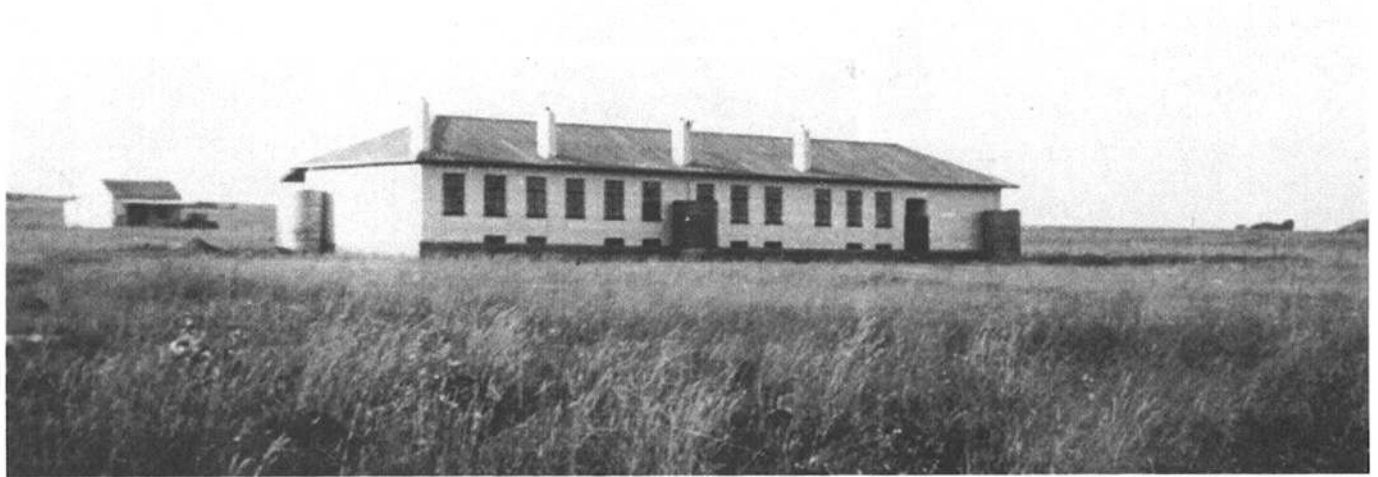

MOOIPLAAS 69 / ERASMIASE LAERSKOOI

Mooiplaas 69 / Erasmiase Laerskool.

Tydens die Anglo Boere Oorlog het skoolaktiwiteite in die Mooiplaas/Hoekplaas omgewing tot stilstand gekom. Na die oorlog (1902) het die ouers op 'n privaat informele basis, sonder staats hulp, skooling aan hulle kinders gegee.

Op 2 Julie 1906 is 'n "Goewerment" skool deur die regering begin. Die hoof was mnr. R.C. van Broekhuizen (later dokter) en 'n leerlingstal van 25 het in 'n ou vervalle woonhuis op Hoekplaas betrek. Die Departement se Inspektors het by verskeie geleenthede gerapporteer dat die huis ongeskik vir die doel is en selfs in gevaar vir die leerlinge inhou.

As gevolg van die toestand van die gebou het Tienie en Lettie Skinner hulle huis op Mooiplaas aangebied en is die skool gedurende 1909 na hulle huis verskuif. Teneinde die getal leerlinge te verskeer het Tienie en Lettie selfs losies aan kinders wat ver woon, verskaf.

Hierina het Tienie op eie inisiatief, begin om 'n skoolgebou met klip op sy plaas te bou. Die klipgebou is gedurende 1914 betrek. Die geriewe het baie verskil met dit wat ons vandag geniet. Aparte put kolektie is vir dogters en seuns gebou. Water is met 'n kerkwa vanaf 'n water voer uit die rivier aangerig en langs die skool geparkeer, die seuns van die skool het die kerkwa na die water voer en terug getrek. Vir die kinders wat van ver, Knoppieslaagte en ander plase, per perd of donkie skool toe gekom het.

is 'n kamp ingerig waar die diere tot na skool gehou was.

Die skoolgebou het aanvanklik bestaan uit twee groot klaskamers en 'n kantoor/stoorkamer, later is 'n toegeboude stoep bygevoeg wat ook as klaskamer benut is.

Tussen die twee klaskamers se brune muur was hout panele wat verwyder kon word om sodanig 'n "saal" te skep wat deur die skool en gemeenskap tydens konserte, vergaderings, kerksake ens. benut kon word - Hierdie klipgebou is tans sover nog in 'n goeie toestand -

Met die depressie en droogte in 1933 was talle blankes in ander haarkomse soek en het hulle by die diamant delwerye en verskeie Dam projekte soos by Boegoeberg en ander 'n verdienste bekom. Gedurende 1934 het Iscor/Iskor begin met die konstruksie van sy fabriek by Pretoria West en is die eerste staal gedurende 1936 geproduseer. Met die voltooiing van die onderskeie damme en die riskante bestaan op die delwerye het talle blankes daaropdaan na Iskor gekom om te werk.

Hier op Mooiplaas het meer as vyftig gesinne hulle gevestig, nadat hulle toestemming by die plaas eienaars gekry het om hulle sielshuisies op te slaan. Meeste van hulle het hier vandaan per fiets na Iskor gery om te werk; party het selfs werkskepe gestap.

Hierdie nuwe inwoners het in drastiese vermeerdering van skoliere meegebring en was die fasiliteite by die klip skool nie meer voldoende nie.

During the Anglo Boer War all schooling activities in the Mooiplaas/Hoekplaas area were stopped. After the war (1902) the parents decided to go on with schooling on an informal basis without any support from the government.

On the 2 of July 1906 a "Goewerment Skool" was started with the headmaster Mr. R.C. van Broekhuizen (later doctor) and a total of 25 children started the first day of school in a very old house on the farm Hoekplaas. Inspectors of the Department declared on many times that the house was unfit for any school activities and that the safety of the children was in balance.

Because of the safety hazards of the school, Tienie and Lettie Skinner decided to offer their house as a school. During 1909 the school moved to the house of Mr and Mrs Skinner. In order to keep the number of children constant in the school Mr and Mrs Skinner decided to give lodging to children that came from a far.

After this Mr. Skinner decide to use his own initiative and started building a stone building on his farm to serve as a school. This Stone school was opened in 1914.

This building differs from those that we know today in the sense that the toilet facilities during this time consisted of "put toilets" in separate areas for boys and for girls. The boys of the school pulled a water-wagon from the river to the school during the mornings the wagon was parked next to the school and was pulled down to the river every day.

Some of the children came from other farms in the area (Knoppieslaagte, Valhalla and Mndani) on horseback and donkey. A separate camp was build where the animals where kept until after school.

The school building consisted of two classrooms and an office/storeroom, later a porch was added and closed of to be used as a third classroom. Between the two classes a wooden panel was installed that could be removed so that a bigger room could be used as a hall for meetings, concert, church etc. Today 2001 the building is still in a good condition.

During the depression and drought in 1933 a lot of the people living in this areas were forced to move and to look for better opportunities elsewhere.

During 1934 Iscor started construction of their factories in Pretoria West and started processing steel during 1936. New families moved to this area in search for work in the factories.

On Mooiplaas 50 families started building their Corrugated houses after they got permission from the farm owners. Most of these men walked to Iscor or took the long road by bicycle.

This sudden rise of families caused a drastically rise in children in the school and the old stone building could no longer be used for schooling.

Hierdie skoolgebou het vier groot klaskeure
in kantoor, stoorkeure en twee slaapkamers vir
seuns en dogters gehad. Toilette was steeds die
put tipe. Water is aanvanklik verkry uit tanks
wat die dakwater opgevang het.

Verseke boor pogings was nie suksesvol nie maar
ten einde raad het die Departement in gade
langs die rivier gebore en water geleë en dit
toe daar vandaan na die skool gepomp.

Die middelste twee klaskeure kon ook aanmekaar
gesteek word deur die houtpanele in die middel-
muur te verwyder en sodanig 'n groter lokaal te
skep wat deur die skool en die gemeenskap -
Ook Erasmia - benut was.

Aangesien daar nie 'n klaskeure vir elke
skoolstandaard was nie moes daar, meer as een
standaard in dieselfde klaskeure onderrig gegee
word.

Op 8 Junie 1943 is Erasmia op 'n gedeelte
van Mooiplaas gestig. Die dorp het egter a.g.v.
verskeie faktore in die begin nie veel uitgebrei
nie.

To solve this problem the government got hold of a piece of
land about 1/2 kilometre East of the Stone school from the
founder of Erasmia Mr. W.F. Erasmus. An instant building was
built within a few days on this piece of land. The building was
built with huge cement blocks that was bolted together, the
school was known as the KNA school because the building
contractor was named Knap and his name was found in some
of the tiles on the floor. The building consisted of four big
classrooms, an office, a storeroom and two toilets. Toilets
was still of the "put" type and water was stored in tanks next
to the school. Again the two middle classes could be combined
to form a hall that was used by the school and the community
of Erasmia. Because of the fact that there were not enough
classes for all the standards two or three standards was
combined in one classroom.

On 8 June 1943 the town of Erasmia was proclaimed on a part
of Mooiplaas. Because of several reasons the town did not
develop as was planned, and the children of Erasmia attended
the Mooiplaas 69 school. During the Fifties the town of
Erasmia developed even more and the Mooiplaas 69 school
became too small for all the children. A new school building
was built in Erasmia and in 1961 the staff, children and
furniture was moved into the new building in Erasmia and the
KNA school was demolished.

toe in 1961 na die nuwe gebou in Erasmia
oorgeplaas en die KNA gebou gesloop.
Hiermee het die skool 'n nuwe fase inge-
gaan en is die naam ook verander na
Erasmiese Laerskool.

Na mnr. van Broekhuizen se dienstertijd
1906-1909 het verskeie persone die posas
hoof vir kort tydperke beklae.

Vanaf 1922 het mnr. Anton De Winter die
pos as hoof vir 31 jaar gevul en in 1953
met pensioen afgetree. Hy is opgevolg
deur mnr. Martiens Snyman wat na 28 jaar
gedurende 1981 afgetree het.

With this changes the school started a new chapter in its
history and the name was also changed to Erasmiese
Laerskool.

After Mr Broekhuizen's went on pension (1906 - 1909) a lot of
different principals was appointed in short terms. From 1922
Mr. Anton De Winter was principal of the school and went on
pension in 1953. Mr Martiens Snyman who went on pension
after 28 years during 1981 succeeded him.
