#### 6. Discipline

- Detention will now be enforced due to learners not following school rules. This will also include those learners that are continuously late.

#### Detention Procedure:

- A learner will serve detention during both breaks for every 30 demerits accumulated.
- Parents will be informed the Friday before detention commences via SMS/D6.
- Learners' names will be announced on a Monday morning as a reminder to report for detention.
- They will report to the teacher on duty at the start of each break.
- They will be allowed to eat their lunch in the **first 5 minutes** of their detention, thereafter they are to remain quiet for the duration of break while reading.
- Failure to adhere to the detention rules will result in those learners being instructed to copy vocabulary from word lists/dictionaries.
- Learners must carry packed lunches for the duration of the detention week. No learner may go to the tuckshop or send another learner to buy from the tuckshop for them.
- The cultural and sporting activities of the learners in detention will be suspended for that week.
